- 🐾 Ask participants, visitors or spectators for a donation

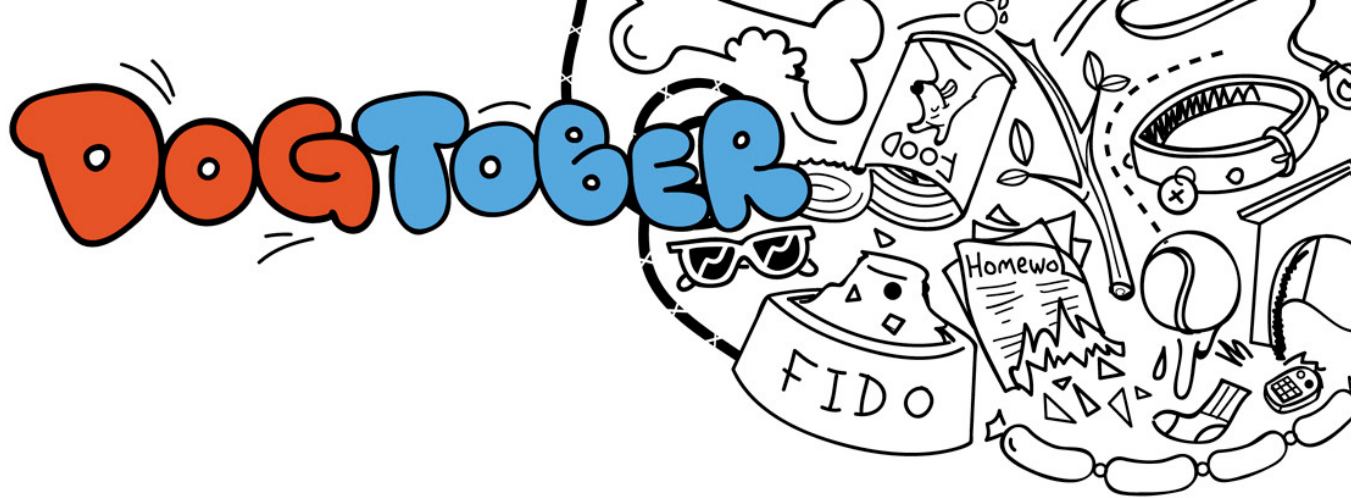
Those are just some examples – _____ (host name) has come up with a unique plan for your very own "DOGTOBER" event for _____ (club name)!
